

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 3:2** "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 4:8** Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor;

<sup>17</sup> From that time Jesus began to proclaim, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

<sup>23</sup> Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and curing every disease and every sickness among the people.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 5:3** "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>10</sup> "Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>19</sup> Therefore, whoever breaks one of the least of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, will be called least in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever does them and teaches them will be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>20</sup> For I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 6:10** Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

<sup>33</sup> But strive first for the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 7:21** "Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 8:11** I tell you, many will come from east and west and will eat with Abraham and Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven,

<sup>12</sup> while the heirs of the kingdom will be thrown into the outer darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 9:35** Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and curing every disease and every sickness.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 10:7** As you go, proclaim the good news, 'The kingdom of heaven has come near.'

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 11:11** Truly I tell you, among those born of women no one has arisen greater than John the Baptist; yet the least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he.

<sup>12</sup> From the days of John the Baptist until now the kingdom of heaven has suffered violence, and the violent take it by force.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 12:25** He knew what they were thinking and said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself is laid waste, and no city or house divided against itself will stand.

<sup>26</sup> If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself; how then will his kingdom stand?

<sup>28</sup> But if it is by the Spirit of God that I cast out demons, then the kingdom of God has come to you.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 13:11** He answered, "To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it has not been given.

<sup>19</sup> When anyone hears the word of the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what is sown in the heart; this is what was sown on the path.

<sup>24</sup> He put before them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to someone who sowed good seed in his field;

<sup>31</sup> He put before them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that someone took and sowed in his field;

<sup>33</sup> He told them another parable: "The kingdom of heaven is like yeast that a woman took and mixed in with three measures of flour until all of it was leavened."

<sup>38</sup> the field is the world, and the good seed are the children of the kingdom; the weeds are the children of the evil one,

<sup>41</sup> The Son of Man will send his angels, and they will collect out of his kingdom all causes of sin and all evildoers,

<sup>43</sup> Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Let anyone with ears listen!

<sup>44</sup> "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which someone found and hid; then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

<sup>45</sup> "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls;

<sup>47</sup> "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net that was thrown into the sea and caught fish of every kind;

<sup>52</sup> And he said to them, "Therefore every scribe who has been trained for the kingdom of heaven is like the master of a household who brings out of his treasure what is new and what is old."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 16:19** I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

<sup>28</sup> Truly I tell you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 18:1** At that time the disciples came to Jesus and asked, "Who is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven?"

<sup>3</sup> and said, "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>4</sup> Whoever becomes humble like this child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>23</sup> "For this reason the kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who wished to settle accounts with his slaves.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 19:12** For there are eunuchs who have been so from birth, and there are eunuchs who have been made eunuchs by others, and there are eunuchs who have made themselves eunuchs for the sake of the kingdom of heaven. Let anyone accept this who can."

<sup>14</sup> but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of heaven belongs."

<sup>23</sup> Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Truly I tell you, it will be hard for a rich person to enter the kingdom of heaven.

<sup>24</sup> Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 20:1** "For the kingdom of heaven is like a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire laborers for his vineyard.

<sup>21</sup> And he said to her, "What do you want?" She said to him, "Declare that these two sons of mine will sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your kingdom."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 21:31** Which of the two did the will of his father?" They said, "The first." Jesus said to them, "Truly I tell you, the tax collectors and the prostitutes are going into the kingdom of God ahead of you.

<sup>43</sup> Therefore I tell you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people that produces the fruits of the kingdom.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 22:2** "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding banquet for his son.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 23:13** "But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you lock people out of the kingdom of heaven. For you do not go in yourselves, and when others are going in, you stop them.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 24:7** For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be famines and earthquakes in various places:

<sup>14</sup> And this good news of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the world, as a testimony to all the nations; and then the end will come.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 25:1** "Then the kingdom of heaven will be like this. Ten bridesmaids took their lamps and went to meet the bridegroom.

<sup>34</sup> Then the king will say to those at his right hand, 'Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world;

<sup>NRS</sup> **Matthew 26:29** I tell you, I will never again drink of this fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 1:15** and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has come near; repent, and believe in the good news."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 3:24** If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 4:11** And he said to them, "To you has been given the secret of the kingdom of God, but for those outside, everything comes in parables;

<sup>26</sup> He also said, "The kingdom of God is as if someone would scatter seed on the ground,

<sup>30</sup> He also said, "With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable will we use for it?

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 6:23** And he solemnly swore to her, "Whatever you ask me, I will give you, even half of my kingdom."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 9:1** And he said to them, "Truly I tell you, there are some standing here who will not taste death until they see that the kingdom of God has come with power."

<sup>47</sup> And if your eye causes you to stumble, tear it out; it is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye than to have two eyes and to be thrown into hell,

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 10:14** But when Jesus saw this, he was indignant and said to them, "Let the little children come to me; do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs.

<sup>15</sup> Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it."

<sup>23</sup> Then Jesus looked around and said to his disciples, "How hard it will be for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!"

<sup>24</sup> And the disciples were perplexed at these words. But Jesus said to them again, "Children, how hard it is to enter the kingdom of God!

<sup>25</sup> It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 11:10** Blessed is the coming kingdom of our ancestor David! Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 12:34** When Jesus saw that he answered wisely, he said to him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." After that no one dared to ask him any question.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 13:8** For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; there will be earthquakes in various places; there will be famines. This is but the beginning of the birth pangs.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 14:25** Truly I tell you, I will never again drink of the fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Mark 15:43** Joseph of Arimathea, a respected member of the council, who was also himself waiting expectantly for the kingdom of God, went boldly to Pilate and asked for the body of Jesus.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 1:33** He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 4:5** Then the devil led him up and showed him in an instant all the kingdoms of the world.

<sup>43</sup> But he said to them, "I must proclaim the good news of the kingdom of God to the other cities also; for I was sent for this purpose."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 6:20** Then he looked up at his disciples and said: "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 7:28** I tell you, among those born of women no one is greater than John; yet the least in the kingdom of God is greater than he."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 8:1** Soon afterwards he went on through cities and villages, proclaiming and bringing the good news of the kingdom of God. The twelve were with him,

<sup>10</sup> He said, "To you it has been given to know the secrets of the kingdom of God; but to others I speak in parables, so that 'looking they may not perceive, and listening they may not understand.'

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 9:2** and he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal.

<sup>11</sup> When the crowds found out about it, they followed him; and he welcomed them, and spoke to them about the kingdom of God, and healed those who needed to be cured.

<sup>27</sup> But truly I tell you, there are some standing here who will not taste death before they see the kingdom of God."

<sup>60</sup> But Jesus said to him, "Let the dead bury their own dead; but as for you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God."

<sup>62</sup> Jesus said to him, "No one who puts a hand to the plow and looks back is fit for the kingdom of God."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 10:9** cure the sick who are there, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'

<sup>11</sup> 'Even the dust of your town that clings to our feet, we wipe off in protest against you. Yet know this: the kingdom of God has come near.'

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 11:2** He said to them, "When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name. Your kingdom come.

<sup>17</sup> But he knew what they were thinking and said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself becomes a desert, and house falls on house.

<sup>18</sup> If Satan also is divided against himself, how will his kingdom stand?-- for you say that I cast out the demons by Beelzebul.

<sup>20</sup> But if it is by the finger of God that I cast out the demons, then the kingdom of God has come to you.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 12:31** Instead, strive for his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well.

<sup>32</sup> "Do not be afraid, little flock, for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 13:18** He said therefore, "What is the kingdom of God like? And to what should I compare it?

<sup>20</sup> And again he said, "To what should I compare the kingdom of God?

<sup>28</sup> There will be weeping and gnashing of teeth when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, and you yourselves thrown out.

<sup>29</sup> Then people will come from east and west, from north and south, and will eat in the kingdom of God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 14:15** One of the dinner guests, on hearing this, said to him, "Blessed is anyone who will eat bread in the kingdom of God!"

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 16:16** "The law and the prophets were in effect until John came; since then the good news of the kingdom of God is proclaimed, and everyone tries to enter it by force.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 17:20** Once Jesus was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God was coming, and he answered, "The kingdom of God is not coming with things that can be observed;

<sup>21</sup> nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or 'There it is!' For, in fact, the kingdom of God is among you."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 18:16** But Jesus called for them and said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs.

<sup>17</sup> Truly I tell you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God as a little child will never enter it."

<sup>24</sup> Jesus looked at him and said, "How hard it is for those who have wealth to enter the kingdom of God!

<sup>25</sup> Indeed, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God."

<sup>29</sup> And he said to them, "Truly I tell you, there is no one who has left house or wife or brothers or parents or children, for the sake of the kingdom of God,

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 19:11** As they were listening to this, he went on to tell a parable, because he was near Jerusalem, and because they supposed that the kingdom of God was to appear immediately.

<sup>12</sup> So he said, "A nobleman went to a distant country to get royal power for himself and then return.

<sup>15</sup> When he returned, having received royal power, he ordered these slaves, to whom he had given the money, to be summoned so that he might find out what they had gained by trading.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 21:10** Then he said to them, "Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom;

<sup>31</sup> So also, when you see these things taking place, you know that the kingdom of God is near.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 22:16** for I tell you, I will not eat it until it is fulfilled in the kingdom of God."

<sup>18</sup> for I tell you that from now on I will not drink of the fruit of the vine until the kingdom of God comes."

<sup>29</sup> and I confer on you, just as my Father has conferred on me, a kingdom,

<sup>30</sup> so that you may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom, and you will sit on thrones judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Luke 23:42** Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

<sup>51</sup> had not agreed to their plan and action. He came from the Jewish town of Arimathea, and he was waiting expectantly for the kingdom of God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **John 3:3** Jesus answered him, "Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above."

<sup>5</sup> Jesus answered, "Very truly, I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit.

<sup>NRS</sup> **John 18:36** Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not from this world. If my kingdom were from this world, my followers would be fighting to keep me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, my kingdom is not from here."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Acts 1:3** After his suffering he presented himself alive to them by many convincing proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God.

<sup>6</sup> So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?"

<sup>NRS</sup> **Acts 8:12** But when they believed Philip, who was proclaiming the good news about the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Acts 14:22** There they strengthened the souls of the disciples and encouraged them to continue in the faith, saying, "It is through many persecutions that we must enter the kingdom of God."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Acts 19:8** He entered the synagogue and for three months spoke out boldly, and argued persuasively about the kingdom of God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Acts 20:25** "And now I know that none of you, among whom I have gone about proclaiming the kingdom, will ever see my face again.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Acts 28:23** After they had set a day to meet with him, they came to him at his lodgings in great numbers. From morning until evening he explained the matter to them, testifying to the kingdom of God and trying to convince them about Jesus both from the law of Moses and from the prophets.

<sup>31</sup> proclaiming the kingdom of God and teaching about the Lord Jesus Christ with all boldness and without hindrance.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Romans 14:17** For the kingdom of God is not food and drink but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

<sup>NRS</sup> **1 Corinthians 4:20** For the kingdom of God depends not on talk but on power.

<sup>NRS</sup> **1 Corinthians 6:9** Do you not know that wrongdoers will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived! Fornicators, idolaters, adulterers, male prostitutes, sodomites,

<sup>10</sup> thieves, the greedy, drunkards, revilers, robbers-- none of these will inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **1 Corinthians 15:24** Then comes the end, when he hands over the kingdom to God the Father, after he has destroyed every ruler and every authority and power.

<sup>50</sup> What I am saying, brothers and sisters, is this: flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Galatians 5:21** envy, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these. I am warning you, as I warned you before: those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Ephesians 5:5** Be sure of this, that no fornicator or impure person, or one who is greedy (that is, an idolater), has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Colossians 1:13** He has rescued us from the power of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of his beloved Son,

<sup>NRS</sup> **Colossians 4:11** And Jesus who is called Justus greets you. These are the only ones of the circumcision among my co-workers for the kingdom of God, and they have been a comfort to me.

<sup>NRS</sup> **1 Thessalonians 2:12** urging and encouraging you and pleading that you lead a life worthy of God, who calls you into his own kingdom and glory.

<sup>NRS</sup> **2 Thessalonians 1:5** This is evidence of the righteous judgment of God, and is intended to make you worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you are also suffering.

<sup>NRS</sup> **2 Timothy 4:1** In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and in view of his appearing and his kingdom, I solemnly urge you:

<sup>18</sup> The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and save me for his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Hebrews 1:8** But of the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, and the righteous scepter is the scepter of your kingdom.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Hebrews 11:33** who through faith conquered kingdoms, administered justice, obtained promises, shut the mouths of lions,

<sup>NRS</sup> **Hebrews 12:28** Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us give thanks, by which we offer to God an acceptable worship with reverence and awe;

<sup>NRS</sup> **James 2:5** Listen, my beloved brothers and sisters. Has not God chosen the poor in the world to be rich in faith and to be heirs of the kingdom that he has promised to those who love him?

<sup>NRS</sup> **2 Peter 1:11** For in this way, entry into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ will be richly provided for you.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Revelation 1:6** and made us to be a kingdom, priests serving his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

<sup>9</sup> I, John, your brother who share with you in Jesus the persecution and the kingdom and the patient endurance, was on the island called Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Revelation 5:10** you have made them to be a kingdom and priests serving our God, and they will reign on earth."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Revelation 11:15** Then the seventh angel blew his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and he will reign forever and ever."

<sup>NRS</sup> **Revelation 12:10** Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, proclaiming, "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Messiah, for the accuser of our comrades has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God.

<sup>NRS</sup> **Revelation 16:10** The fifth angel poured his bowl on the throne of the beast, and its kingdom was plunged into darkness; people gnawed their tongues in agony,

<sup>NRS</sup> **Revelation 17:12** And the ten horns that you saw are ten kings who have not yet received a kingdom, but they are to receive authority as kings for one hour, together with the beast.

<sup>17</sup> For God has put it into their hearts to carry out his purpose by agreeing to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God will be fulfilled.
